<b>EFFICIENT</b>	<b>4 - 6</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All hazards identified but not effectively managed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extrication plan developed, but IC is slow to recognise problems</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>IC's skills are clearly recognisable, some instances occur where focus is lost or issues missed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>IC ensures PPE used appropriately</li> <li>Some attention is paid to manual handling and monitoring of potential causes of injury to members.</li> <li>Occasional re-assessment of size up and rotation of team members</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>IC provides some encouragement but a good tempo is not maintained throughout the evolution</li> </ul>

<b>THOROUGH</b>	<b>7 - 10</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All hazards identified and managed effectively (eliminate, isolate or remove)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extrication plan developed with awareness of access, extrication and pathway options.</li> <li>Regular reassessment throughout the evolution.</li> <li>Potential problems anticipated and plan modified as necessary momentum maintained</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Thorough command skills demonstrated throughout the evolution.</li> <li>Positioning appropriate throughout</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>IC effectively controls safety and ensures all team make full use of PPE at all times.</li> <li>Scene is thoroughly and regularly re-assessed.</li> <li>Manual handling well managed and team regularly rotated.</li> <li>IC is constantly aware of potential effect on team members of each action they undertake and correcting any as necessary (e.g. working in the path of undeployed SRS)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>IC effectively motivates and encourages team and a good tempo is maintained throughout the evolution</li> </ul>
